1. The one-of-a-kind headboard is made of Japanese silk pressed between recycled-glass panels and lit from within.
2. The east wall covering is made of bark.
3. A fox-fur blanket that, while maybe not the most animal-friendly, sure is soft.
4. The forty-seven-inch LG plays "Kiss," a video piece by R. Luke DuBois that renders kissing scenes from famous films into a series of lines and dots.
5. Instead of a four-post bed, English commissioned floor-to-ceiling strings of handmade beads, meant to remind visitors of the heel of a woman's shoe.
6. In the adjoining master closet hangs *Moose* by *Specimen Cases at Deyrolle*, a six-foot photo of a moose by William Curtis Rolf.

1. Eight custom recliners sit on a sixteen-foot turntable. In thirty seconds, the turntable can rotate from facing the gaming wall to facing the television wall.
2. Like nearly everything else created in the last eight months, the whole system can be controlled by an iPad.
3. A pair of limited-edition Les Paul Signature CS3.7 speakers from Thiel. It's one of only ten, each signed by Les Paul. It's one of only one also signed by Spike Lee, Amy Poehler, and the Doors' Ray Manzarek.
4. The first 3-D TVs that do not require glasses will be released later this year.
5. In 2008 more than forty-seven billion gallons of beer were consumed globally.
6. Which led (indirectly) to this countertop, which is made out of recycled beer bottles.
